The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking restoration of the deductions made from the payment of Additional Dearness Allowance.

In support of the claim, the petitioners are relying upon the judgments of this Court passed in CWP No. 4518 of 2000 dated 11.08.2003 and CWP No. 16084 of 1997, dated 27.07.2000 and judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court passed in Civil Appeal No. 8661 of 2009, dated 08.12.2015.

Petitioners claim that they are similarly situated with those who have been granted the relief by this Court but the same has not been granted to them only on the ground that they have not approached this Court and were not the petitioners in above mentioned writ petitions.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be

satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide their representation dated 01.08.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Keeping in view the request made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioners in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 01.08.2017 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any monetary relief, the same shall also be released to them within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of .
