In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been given the reimbursement of the medical bills in respect of the treatment of her husband, who was suffering from Renal problem and also was Diabetic and unfortunately died on 03.11.2018 during the treatment.

From the pleadings, it transpires that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice

dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
