GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. This order shall dispose of the aforementioned petitions filed on behalf of Raman Kumar and Manjit Singh @ Sunny seeking anticipatory bail in respect of FIR registered against them vide FIR No.89 dated 9.5.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station Moga, District Moga.
2. The FIR was registered at the instance of Harjit Singh, wherein it has been alleged that on the date of occurrence after he had taken his examination, he was attacked by Gurpreet Singh and others and that

Sunny fired at him.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the injuries are simple in nature and that in fact the petitioner Raman Kumar is not even named in the FIR. It has further been submitted that parties had in fact resolved the dispute and entered into a compromise.
4. The complainant is present in person along with his counsel Sh. Vikas Garg, who has endorsed the fact that the parties have indeed compromised the matter.
5. The aforestated position is not disputed by the learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Manpreet Singh.
6. Having regard the aforestated position where the petitioner and complainant are stated to have resolved the dispute and had compromised the matter, the petitions, as such are accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 6.12.2018 passed in CRM-M-53821-2018 and order dated 15.12.2018 passed in CRM-M-55187-2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
6. The petitions are accepted in the abovementioned terms.
