DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by petitioner-Yashpal @ Bagi for grant of regular bail to him in case FIR No. 123 dated 27.3.2018 registered under Sections 148,149,307,427,506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is at par with co-accused, namely, Sumit, Krishan, Parkash and Mahesh, who have approached this Court by way of filing Crl. Misc. Nos. 39622,41444,44255 and 53793 of 2018, respectively, for grant of regular bail, which were allowed vide different orders and they have been ordered to be released on bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that it is no injury case and the petitioner is in custody since 10.11.2018.

Learned counsel for respondent-State has not disputed the custody period as well as release of co-accused on regular bail. However, he opposed the bail on the ground that four more cases are there against the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is on bail in all the cases.

Keeping in view the parity with co-accused, namely, Sumit, Krishan, Parkash and Mahesh, who have been attributed the same role and have been released on regular bail as well as custody of the petitioner since 10.11.2018, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Yashpal @ Bagi is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
