Through this revision petition, correctness of the order passed by the Court of Sessions dated 15.2.2014, discharging the respondents herein in criminal case arising out of FIR No. 125 dated 12.6.2011 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Beri has been challenged.

Learned Court of Sessions has found that Om Parkash was married to Rekha and due to matrimonial discord Om Parkash had consumed aluminium phosphide as detected in the report of Forensic Science Laboratory. During investigation it has come on record that there was no eye witness of the quarrel that allegedly took place between the husband and wife. As per the observations made by the learned Court Om Parkash and his wife - Rekha used to quarrel as Om Parkash had suspicion that his wife Rekha had illicit relations with Shashi. However, no material to that effect was collected. Further the Court has found that

such suspicion would not result in abetment to commit suicide.

In view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out. Dismissed.
