Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.265 dated 24.11.2017 under Sections 353, 186 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, following order was passed on 06.12.2018: -

*“.....Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, both the accused fled away on the motorcycle after the occurrence and the motorcycle was taken in possession by the police on the same day i.e. 24.11.2017 and therefore, the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case.....”*

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required

for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 06.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
