The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petition may be dismissed as withdrawn and that some directions may be issued for expediting the trial.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court is, however, directed to make strenuous efforts to ensure that the trial is concluded expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from today.

The trial Court shall take effective steps for securing the presence of all the witnesses and fix short dates so as to ensure that the trial is not unnecessarily delayed. The trial Court may take up the matter with the Superintendent of Police concerned in case the witnesses do not turn up on the dates fixed.
