Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.96 dated 09.11.2017, registered at Police Station Jalandhar Cantt., District Jalandhar, under Sections 302, 404 and 34 of the IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of blind murder and appears to be an accidental death. The petitioner has been named in the supplementary statement of complainant recorded on

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17.11.2017. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the case of prosecution, the petitioner has been connected with the commission of offence on the basis of alleged recovery of *Aadhar* card of the deceased from him, whereas no recovery has been effected from him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 05.12.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
