Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate action on the complaint/representation dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-1), which has been recommended to be filed by respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complaint dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been filed without taking into account the documentary evidence, which was submitted along with the complaint. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondents to consider the same in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.3-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
