Petitioners Avtar Singh and Rajveer Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.80 dated 10.04.2019, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners on 31.05.2019 gave the undertaking that the petitioners will deposit the loan amount taken by Rajveer Singh in the name of Amarjit Singh along with interest etc. till the next date i.e. 10.07.2019. The petitioners were granted the benefit of interim bail on that date. On the next date, he again requested for short date

for depositing the loan amount in question. Today, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the loan amount has not been paid as per the undertaking.

Keeping in the view the fact that the petitioners have not complied with their own undertaking which shows their conduct, they are not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail. Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
