On 28.05.2019, the following order was passed:

“Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No.5 dated 10.01.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148, 149, 427 IPC, Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 326 and 452 IPC (added later on), Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana.

According to the prosecution, two rival groups consisting of 10-15 persons each fought with each other. Petitioners were also the members of one of the groups at the time of occurrence.

Learned counsel contends that compromise has been arrived at between the parties. Co-accused of the petitioners namely, Baljinder Singh @ Rinku Thukral, Himanshu Malhotra and Manjinder Singh have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide separate orders dated 06.05.2019, 09.05.2019 and 21.05.2019 respectively. Treating the case of the petitioners on the same parity, they may also be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion for 27.09.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Balkar Singh, has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

Hence, the order dated 28.05.2019 is made absolute.
