Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioners herein as also respondent No.5 had participated in a tender process relating to carriage and transport of food grains for the year 2019-20 pertaining to four clusters i.e. Phagwara, Kapurthala-2, Dhilwan-2 and Sultanpur Lodhi.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that in spite of the petitioners having brought to the notice of the Chairman, District Tender Committee, Kapurthala that respondent No.5 has furnished false and fabricated details regarding the vehicles that had been offered for the carriage and transport of the food grains, no legal action is being initiated against them.

Counsel submits that this is in spite of Note-V contained in the Transportation of Food Grains Policy issued by the State of Punjab at Annexure P-1. He further submits that even the representation dated 30.04.2019 at Annexure P-6 has been made and

he would be satisfied if directions are issued to the Chairman, District Tender Committee, Kapurthala to look into the matter.

Submissions made by the counsel are found to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the matter against the backdrop of representation dated 30.04.2019 at Annexure P-6 and thereafter to take steps as are deemed fit and as warranted in accordance with law. Ordered accordingly.
