GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.92 dated 2.3.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 06.12.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements

recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Anupuma Kochar have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar that the compromise is genuine and has been effected between the parties without any pressure and the same seems to be genuine.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.92 dated 2.3.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
