This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.41 dated 07.3.2009, under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 05.02.2014 and he is still a proclaimed offender. The petition for quashing of FIR is founded on the ground that other co-accused persons have been acquitted on 20.12.2014.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner and the fact that the evidence recorded by the trial Court cannot be taken into consideration in

respect of the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is dismissed.
