The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.855 dated 26.10.2018, registered under Sections 195-A, 354, 354-D, 506 IPC, at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he has threatened the complainant on telephone to withdraw the case and he has also personally gone in the court premises.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 07.12.2018 is made

absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and also subject to the conditions that he will not visit the vicinity of the complainant and will not indulge in any telephonic conversation with her.

Petition stands allowed.
