Through this revision, the complainant has laid challenge to the judgment dated 05.04.2016 of the Appellate Court and the judgment dated 03.11.2014 of the trial Court, whereby respondent Nos.1 & 2 (hereinafter referred to as 'private respondents') were acquitted.

In nutshell, the private respondents on 10.04.2004 illegally occupied House No.2782, Sector-22-C, Chandigarh by breaking its locks put by the petitioner. The above allegation was culminated into FIR No.167 dated 15.04.2004 under Sections 380/452 IPC, Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh. Thereafter the private respondents were tried and acquitted by the trial Court vide the aforesaid judgment, which was affirmed by the First Appellate Court.

Heard.

After going through the judgments of Courts below, this Court finds no illegality or perversity inasmuch as the petitioner, despite affording several opportunities, did not come present and offer himself for his cross-examination. Therefore, the trial Court was legally bound to acquit the

private respondents in the absence of any evidence against them what to talk

of cogent & convincing.

Therefore, no case is made out to interfere with the judgments
of the Courts below.
