The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.612 dated 03.08.2017 registered under Sections 420, 409, 467, 468, 471, 507, 120-B of IPC and Section 3 Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013, at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was only an employee of the Financial Society. He was working as Zonal Manager of Society, however, he had resigned from the same on 03.10.2016. Rather on coming to know of improper business by the Society, the petitioner has raised a complaint against financial irregularity. It is further submitted that no money has been received by the petitioner from the investors in his personal account. Rather the money was deposited in the account of the Society. Still further, it is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2018 and even the complainant has been examined as witness before the trial Court. Hence, the petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Satish Kumar, submits that the petitioner is involved in a case regarding cheating with so many people. However, it is not denied that the petitioner was only an employee of the Society and that no money has gone in his personal account; except his salary. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2018 and that the complainant has been examined in the case.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
