The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 21.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 1654 of 2019. The operational part of the order is quoted below:

“In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representations dated 26.10.2018 and 30.11.2018 (Annexure P-9 (colly)) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the said representations, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.”

A reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. S.K.Makkar, Executive Engineer, Central Store, UHBVN, Panipat filed in Court today is taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the

petitioner. Along with copy of order dated 12.06.2019 is annexed, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after passing of the order, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, liberty is sought to avail remedies to challenge the said order.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
