Petitioner No.1-Dharam Singh has handed over a demand draft bearing No. 764959 dated 01.11.2019 amounting to ₹5 lacs drawn on Yes Bank Limited (photocopy of which has been placed on the record), to respondent No.2 which has been received by respondent No.2-Archana, in the Court today

Report dated 20.05.2019 of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dera Bassi has been received whereby after

recording statements of respondent No.2-Archana and accused/petitioners, namely, Dharam Singh, Dayal Singh and Kamlesh Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have shown their resolve to end the dispute and have made statements that they have compromised the matter as per Annexure P-2 and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.187 dated 14.05.2013 registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
