Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to take action in accordance with law in relation to representation/complaint dated 20.2.2019 (Annexure P-12) and also recommendation made by respondent No.9 vide resolution dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the representation is already submitted on 20.2.2019 to the SSP, Police District Khanna, however, no FIR has been registered till date.

A perusal of the representation (Annexure P-12) reveals that on the basis of complaint given by the petitioner, an inquiry was conducted by the Joint Registrar Co-operative Societies, Punjab and subsequently,

Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Samrala sent the communication in this regard to the SSP, Police District Khanna on 22.11.2018.

Since the complaint in respect of the alleged embezzlement has been acted upon by the office of the Registrar Co-operative Societies, Punjab, therefore, this Court does not find any valid reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions for registration of the case.

The petition stands dismissed.
