Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the report from the FSL, as regards the handwriting on the suicide note, has been received, stating to the effect that there is “similarity” in the hand-writing of the signatures when seen with the standard handwriting/signatures of the deceased.

He however submits that presently at least, the petitioners' custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the interim order dated 29.05.2019 passed by this Court, is made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
