1. Result of the petitioner has been produced in sealed cover alongwith OMR sheet and cut off marks of the last candidate selected in the General Category for the post of Male Constable (GD) Police Department, Haryana in respect of Advertisement No.03/2018 Category No.01.
2. Perusal of the result produced reveals that the petitioner secured 44.80 out of 80 marks on account of written examination, 4 marks on account of Graduation, 3 marks on account of NCC and 5 marks out of 10 marks on account of socio-economic criteria, total 56.80 out of 100 marks whereas the last selected candidate secured 57.60.
3. Grievance of the petitioner is that he was not properly evaluated for Question No.100. However, on perusal of the OMR Sheet, learned counsel states that he does not press the writ petition in view of the petitioner having wrongly answered Question No.100 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the writ petition.
4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
5. Result of the petitioner along with OMR sheet as produced by learned Senior DAG, Haryana is resealed and returned.
