The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 381 dated 03.05.2019, under Sections 323, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had entered into the house of the complainant and had given beatings to her and her son. He also contends that the complainant is the wife of the petitioner and they had separated about five years ago and he is paying maintenance of ₹10,000/- per month and the FIR has been filed just to pressurize the petitioner to increase the maintenance. He further contends that there was no injury on the complainant or her son Aditya, as there is no MLR to this effect

This Court, by order dated 29.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Arun Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 29.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
