ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.37, dated 13.04.2019, under Section 306 read with 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the deceased had committed suicide after the harassment by his wife. The allegations against the petitioners are that they were go between for the marriage of the deceased and his wife and, therefore, the allegations against the petitioners would not, *prima facie*, constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC. They are in custody for over 2 months since their arrest on 13.04.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, states that the challan has been filed but no witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the investigation has been completed and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
