The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 53 dated 10.04.2019, under Sections 21, 27 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the disclosure statement of co-accused Gurpreet Singh from whom 2 grams of heroin was recovered. The petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by the order dated 29.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 29.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
