In compliance to the previous order dated 20.11.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner has filed address of only one doctor, namely; Dr. Asitesh Singh Bajwa @ Antosh Singh Bajwa S/o Gurmit Singh Bajwa, resident of Lane No. 10, Ajit Nagar, Opposite Duggal Battery, Jalandhar, now at DHAS (Dr. Hedgewa Aarogya Sansthan), Hospital, Karkardooma, Delhi (NCT Delhi Government).
