The petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.355 dated 07.08.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram.

The allegations against the petitioner are that the petitioner used forged documents to furnish the surety bonds for one Ashok Kumar, who was accused in case under Section 138 of N.I. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed and charges have been framed. The petitioner is in custody since 05.09.2018. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody.

Keeping in view the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Gurugram.
