Third petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133 dated 29.08.2018, under Sections 61/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Sections 420 & 487 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 added later on), registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner that he will surrender before learned trial Court, but his regular bail application may be decided at the earliest.
