In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is that she retired as CDPO on 31.01.2019 but no retiral benefits has been extended to her though there is no impediment in the release of the same as there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner either departmental or criminal, which would entitle the respondents to withhold her pensionary benefits, hence direction needs to be issued to the respondents for the release of the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.04.2018 (Annexure P-1), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 12.04.2018 (Annexure P-1), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 12.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
