The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for proper investigation in case FIR No.59 dated 01.05.2019, registered under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka and further for issuance of direction to official respondents to take the positive steps to arrest the accused persons and also to record the statements of prosecution witnesses.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although the FIR has been registered on 01.05.2019 yet the accused have not been arrested.

Heard. The instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, to look into the matter and submit the status report to the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate within a period of 60 days, who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. And others; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.**
