This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of the complaint No. NACT/3105.2018 filed by the respondent on 2.5.2018 under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881; the summoning order dated 2.6.2018 and the order dated 6.4.2019 by which non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would not press the prayers for quashing of the complaint and the summoning order dated 2.6.2018 at this stage, and as regards the prayer for quashing of the order dated 6.4.2019 he has argued that petitioner moved an application for exemption which was declined. The petitioner has no intention to avoid appearance and would appear definitely in Court tomorrow.

In my opinion, in these circumstances of the case the direction for securing the presence of the petitioner through non bailable

warrants is set aside.

Let the petitioner appear before the Court on the date fixed i.e. 29.5.2019 and the Trial Court would release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
