AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 20.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 29273 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1- Director, Rural Development & Panchayats, Punjab to ensure that the enquiry in the matter is conducted as per law by respondent No. 2-District Development & Panchayats Officer, SBS Nagar and the same be concluded within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him,

within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

Learned counsel for the State has produced an order dated 7.8.2019 in court, the same is taken on record and copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the order, enquiry has been concluded and warning issued to Rajesh Chadha, Block Development and Panchayat Officer to be aware in future.

In view of the order produced, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law if some grievance still survives.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
