The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.151 dated 26.8.2018, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar, under Sections 392, 384, 365, 115, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms, Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 28.8.2018. The only allegation against him is that he supplied the weapons to the co-accused, who allegedly perpetrated the crime. The co-accused have been granted regular bail by the trial Court and therefore, he may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that there is one more FIR pending against the petitioner under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC. Thus, it would not be safe to grant regular bail to him.

In rebuttal, counsel for the petitioner submits that in the FIR mentioned by the learned State counsel, the petitioner is already on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner-Bikramjit Singh @ Vicky, is ordered to be released

on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial
Court concerned.
