The petitioner is challenging order dated 29.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) whereby her claim for appointment on contract basis has been rejected. A perusal of the order dated 29.04.2019 shows that she was appointed on 10.06.2014 and her last attendance was upto 10.11.2014. Thereafter she left the college without any intimation on the same day. Thereafter she served a legal notice after a gap of more than 3 years and 8 months and as per the policy guidelines of Director General Higher Education Haryana, Panchkula, that if any employee remains absent for more than two consecutive working days then it would entail termination of contract.

The termination order dated 29.04.2019 is not liable to be interfered with simply on the ground that after leaving the job in 2014, she cannot be taken back because she left the College herself.
