The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.239 dated 06.05.2019, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 04 bottles of 100 ml each of ONEREX cough syrup, which is much below the commercial quantity was allegedly recovered. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 19.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sunil, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 19.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
