Prayer in this petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.229 dated 11.04.2019 registered under Sections 365, 511 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sector 7, District Faridabad.

Basic allegations against the petitioner is to the effect that he tried to kidnap the school going son of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is known to the wife of the complainant. He also referred to photographs (Annexure P-2) where wife of the complainant and petitioner are together.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that earlier also, one FIR was registered for theft in which petitioner was granted bail and in spite of grant of bail, petitioner has tried

to kidnap the son of the complainant.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State, on instructions from ASI Satvir, has submitted that investigation is complete and challan has been presented.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner shall not enter the city of Faridabad except to attend the Court cases. Petitioner is resident of different District i.e. Hisar.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
