On 30.05.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not attributed any specific injury to the injured. He further submits that two co-accused namely Amrik Singh and Satnam Singh have already been granted the benefit of pre-arrest bail vide order dated 08.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-16161-2019.

In view thereof, interim order dated 30.05.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.
