This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 1.3.2019 passed in CWP No. 5631 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Petition is disposed of with the direction that legal notice be decided expeditiously, in any case not later than six weeks. If any amount is found due to the petitioner, payment of same would be released to it."

Respondent No.4-Mr. Balbir Singh, Executive Engineer present in Court states that the amount has been transferred to the Chairman and the same would be released to the petitioner within three weeks from today.

In view of above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to revive the same in case the statement made today is not adhered to. It is clarified that if the petitioner is

forced to revive the contempt petition, costs may be imposed which would be recovered from the defaulting officer/official(s).

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
