Learned counsel for the State has produced a copy of Letter No. 8867/SIC/2019/7-1A dated 30.05.2019, which is taken on record.

On instructions from Sh. Krishan Kumar, P.A. To RTI Commissioner, Haryana, it has been submitted by the counsel for the State with regard to the communication Annexures P-8 and P-9 that the Commission was not holding Court on the said date as the Commissioner was likely to be on leave and, therefore, the date was given in advance to avoid any discomfort to the parties.

A perusal of the records indicates that the mercy chance had been given to the respondents who were supposed to supply the information as per the directions issued by the Commission but the said information has not been supplied. The date, which has been given, is quite long as

compared to the initial time which was given by the State Information Commission for supplying the information. The case is now listed for hearing on 05.08.2019 and it is expected that the State Information Commission, Haryana shall take these facts into consideration and pass an appropriate order preferably on the next date of hearing.

With these observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
