Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner-Brish Bhan son of Amarjit Singh in case F.I.R. No.71 dated 30.04.2019 under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and no amount was actually received by the petitioner and even signatures on the receipts by Brish Bhan are disputed by the present petitioner and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh, opposed the petition for pre-arrest bail on the ground that all the allegations

are against petitioner Brish Bhan only and receipts are also under the signatures of the present petitioner and he is required for the purpose of investigation.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for both the sides and the fact that petitioner-Brish Bhan is the main accused in this case who had assured Gurbhej Singh to send him to Germany and receipt regarding payment was issued under the signatures of Brish Bhan only. The matter would be requiring intensive investigation. As such, no case is made out for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and the present petition is dismissed.
