In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners are entitled for the grant of benefit in view of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014, which has been upheld by the LPA Bench while deciding LPA No.352 of 2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in terms of the said judgment, the pensionary benefits of the petitioners are to be revised by giving the benefit of revised pay scale to the petitioners though notionally from the year 2006 onwards and actually w.e.f. 2011 but the said benefit has not been extended to the petitioners without any valid justification though the said judgment has been implemented qua the similarly situated employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served the respondent a legal notice on 23.04.2019 (Annexure P-11) and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 23.04.2019 (Annexure P-11), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 23.04.2019 (Annexure P-11) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
