The petitioners are working on the various posts in Permanent Lok Adalat for Public Utility Services and District Legal Services Authorities in the State of Haryana. The details of their posts, joining, designation are mentioned in para 2 of the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the order passed by this Court in *CWP No. 22747 of 2018 titled Karam Pal and others vs. State of Haryana and others* (Annexure P-8) whereby they were seeking benefit of minimum of the regular pay scale keeping in view the judgment passed by the Supreme Court in the case of *State of Punjab and others V/s. Jagjit Singh and others*, 2016(4) SCT 641. This petition was disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioners and make payment of arrears for 38 months alongwith 6% interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that this order has been complied with by the Member Secretary, Haryana State Legal Services Authority vide order dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-9). Petitioners are seeking same benefit.

Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. A copy of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

Keeping in view that benefit has already been given to similarly situated employees vide order dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-9), this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 16.11.2017 (Annexure P-5) and pass appropriate order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order as per the order passed in ***CWP No. 22747 of 2018 titled Karam Pal and others V/s. State of Haryana and others*** (Annexure P-7).
