AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. She states that in compliance with the order dated 26.02.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has been allowed to join his duties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that benefits which have been granted to similarly situated employees have not been granted to the petitioner.

The operational part of order dated 26.02.2019 is reproduced below:-

“Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed as the action of the respondents keeping the petitioner out of service is not justified and thus the same is set aside. Respondent no.2 is directed to allow the petitioner to join his duties as an Education Volunteer within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to say that the petitioner will not be entitled to any arrears of pay for the period he remained out of job. However, he will be entitled for all other benefits which have been granted to similarly situated employees who were appointed along with the petitioner.”

(emphasis supplied)

Learned counsel for the respondents states that order of this Court (i.e. the emphasized portion of above quoted order) will be complied with within two weeks from today.

In view of statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

In case grievance of the petitioner still survives, he would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
