The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 26.04.2019, registered under Sections 10 & 17 of the POSCO Act and Sections 506 & 120-B of the IPC, at Women Police Station, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

The dispute is between the mother and father of the petitioner. The petitioner is residing in the house of his maternal uncle (mama) along with his mother in different village. Allegations against the petitioner is that he used to harass and tease the prosecutrix and her sister-Anjali, who are his real sisters.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sonu is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty

Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
- (d) He will not visit the house of the prosecutrix.
