The petitioner appearing in person is an Assistant Professor in Maths in Government College for Women, Jassaur Kheri, Tehsil Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar and has approached this Court by filing this Public Interest Litigation seeking the following reliefs:-

"(1) Issuance a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to resolve the problems mentioned in request dated 13.12.2018 (Annexure P-1).

(2) Direct the respondents to visit monthly in college and ensure the proper time table is being followed.

(3) Direct the Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar to insure safety and security of the staff and students and depute permanent cops in college campus and direction to challan the without number plate and modified silencer vehicles.

(4) Direct the respondents to increase the purchasing power of Principal without taking quotation from Rs. 500/- to Rs. 5000/- or above.

(5) Direct the respondents to allow to do purchasing at lowest open market rate from local market and make an inquiry in loot of firms in name of approved sources/Gem.

(6) Direct the respondents to make available the existing internet connection in computer lab of GCW, Jassaur Kheri.

(7) Direct to make an enquiry for taking over the incomplete building of GCW, Jassaur Kheri (Jhajjar) and for taking the possession of whole land of area nearly 10 acres and to make college multipurpose hall echo free.

(8) Direct the college, which are situated in rural area to purchase the newspapers in library at village rates whether higher than printed rate.

(9) Direct the respondents to follow roaster system in university exams duties and random duties are assigned to teachers and Superintendent and other staff be appointed from other colleges and allot the strength by considering infrastructure.

(10) Direct the respondents to shift the helipad from college playground of GC, Bahadurgarh.

(11) Award the cost of filing the writ petition to the petitioner.

(12) Award any other relief Hon'ble High Court want deemed fit in the circumstances of the case.

(13) Exempt from filing the certified and true typed copies of the Annexures and filing of photocopies of Annexures be permitted."

2. It may be relevant to notice at this stage the

detail of a writ petition filed by the petitioner himself being

CWP-13283-2018 raising a grievance with respect to not being granted earned leave in lieu of some additional work which he had performed during summer vacations. The petition was disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1 to treat the said writ petition as representation and pass a speaking order regarding request of earned leave.

3. When confronted, the petitioner appearing in person conceded before us that the dispute is still pending and no decision has been taken. In our considered opinion, this petition in the nature of Public Interest Litigation has actually been filed by the petitioner being motivated by the fact that the dispute is not being settled to his liking.

4. Since the Public Interest Litigation seems to be a personally motivated petition, we dismiss the same.
