The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.46 dated 27.03.2019 registered under Sections 420, 384, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka.

A similar petition, CRM-M-21598 of 2019, filed for anticipatory bail by Gurmeet Kaur, the co-accused of the petitioner has already been dismissed by this Court vide the detailed order dated 13.05.2019. The present petitioner has also fully participated in the alleged fraud of getting the girl married to the complainant for money. The present petitioner acted as a real brother of the bride. Therefore, his role is at par with the co-accused Gurmeet Kaur @ Sukhi @ Sukhpreet Kaur, whose application for anticipatory bail already stand dismissed vide the above-said order.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed in terms of the order dated 13.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-21598 of 2019, **Gurmeet Kaur @ Sukhi @ Sukhpreet Kaur v. State of Punjab.**
