In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for step up of her pay equivalent to the junior reserved category candidate, who was promoted as a Lecturer, ahead of the petitioner on the basis of reservation.

As per the averments made in paragraph 5 of the writ petition, one Mr. Rajbir Singh, who was junior to the petitioner in the cadre of Master/Mistress, was promoted as a Lecturer on 07.05.1992 by giving him the benefit of reservation and the petitioner who belongs to the general category caught him on 05.03.2008 and therefore, the claim which is being made by the petitioner is that she should have been granted the benefit of step up of pay keeping in view the instructions issued by the Government of Haryana dated 27.11.2006, amended from time to time.

As per the averments made in the writ petition, petitioner has submitted the representations (Annexures P-7 to P-9) to the respondents and those representations are still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
