[1] Dr. Puneet K. Sekhon, Advocate has filed memo of appearance in Court today. The same is taken on record.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents state that the University has accepted the claim of the petitioner, therefore, the writ petition can be allowed, impugned orders (Annexures P-3, P-5 and P-6) set aside and the petitioner held entitled to receive the fee paid by her as also the documents submitted by her at the time of admission subject to payment of penalty of ₹ 2.00 lakh.

[3] Stand of counsel for the respondents is acceptable to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the

writ petition is allowed. Impugned orders (Annexures P-3, P-5 and P-6) are

set aside subject to the petitioner depositing ₹ 2.00 lakh on account of penalty imposed by the respondents due to surrender of seat by the petitioner after depositing the admission fee.

[5] On deposit of penalty amount i.e. ₹ 2.00 lakh, the respondents would refund the fee paid by the petitioner i.e. ₹ 7.00 lakh as also the documents furnished by her at the time of admission within a period of three days thereafter.
