TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J (Oral)

Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to provide protection to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents no.5 to 9.

Counsel submits that petitioner was married to respondent no.5. The matrimonial relationship has run into rough weather. Further urged that respondent no.5 as also his close relatives i.e. respondents no.6 to 9 had maltreated and physically assaulted the petitioner and on account of which she had to leave her matrimonial home.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.3. In the eventuality of petitioner filing any application/representation as regards her threat perception, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit in accordance with law.
