In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled for the benefit as extended to the petitioners in CWP No.7855 of 2014 and other connected cases, decided on 17.12.2018 wherein, the petitioners therein have been allowed to exercise the option once again keeping in view the instructions dated 24.12.1992.

Admittedly, the petitioners have not approached the respondents after the order was passed by this Court in CWP No.7855 of 2014 and other connected cases, decided on 17.12.2018 so as to claim the same benefit as extended to the petitioners in CWP No.7855 of 2014.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents for raising grievances as raised in the present writ petition claiming the relief as extended to the petitioners in CWP No.7855 of 2014 and other connected cases, decided on 17.12.2018.
